General Information & Rates

- Kids Care offers a maximum of two hours of care per child per visit.
- Member Rate: \$2 per child, per visit.
- All payments must be made at the Member Services Desk prior to children entering Kids Care. Receipt must be present at time of sign in.
- There is limited space for children ages 6 weeks to 12 months.

Policies & Procedures

- Minnesota State Law requires that parents remain in the building while their child is in Kids Care.
- Parents must follow a sign-in and out procedure that includes providing YWCA staff with a photo ID or YWCA St. Paul Membership Card.
- No child will be released to anyone other than the parents/guardians or other authorized persons listed on the child's registration form.
- Children may not leave the Kids Care area at any time and no child will be left unattended under any circumstances.
- For the safety of children with allergies, we ask that parents and children not bring food/snacks with any type or amount of nuts into the Kids Care area.
- In consideration of YWCA Staff and other children we ask that parents do not bring a child in if he/she has a fever above 98.6, diarrhea or vomiting in the past 24 hours, conjunctivitis, pus draining from eyes, unexplained lethargy, undiagnosed rash or green discharge from the nose.
- For the safety of the children over-the-counter and prescription medication is not permitted or administered in Kids Care. Exceptions may be made for children in need of emergency allergy medications or other special needs.
- For safety reasons children are not allowed to bring toys from home into the Kids Care area.
- For your convenience and privacy we have designated all family and female locker rooms for breast feeding mothers.
- Parents will be asked to return to Kids Care if a child needs a diaper change, has been crying for more than fifteen minutes, becomes ill, is perceived as needing to be fed, receives an injury or is disruptive to the Kids Care environment.
- YWCA St. Paul reserves the right to suspend or revoke Kids Care privileges from any person who neglects the guidelines listed above.
