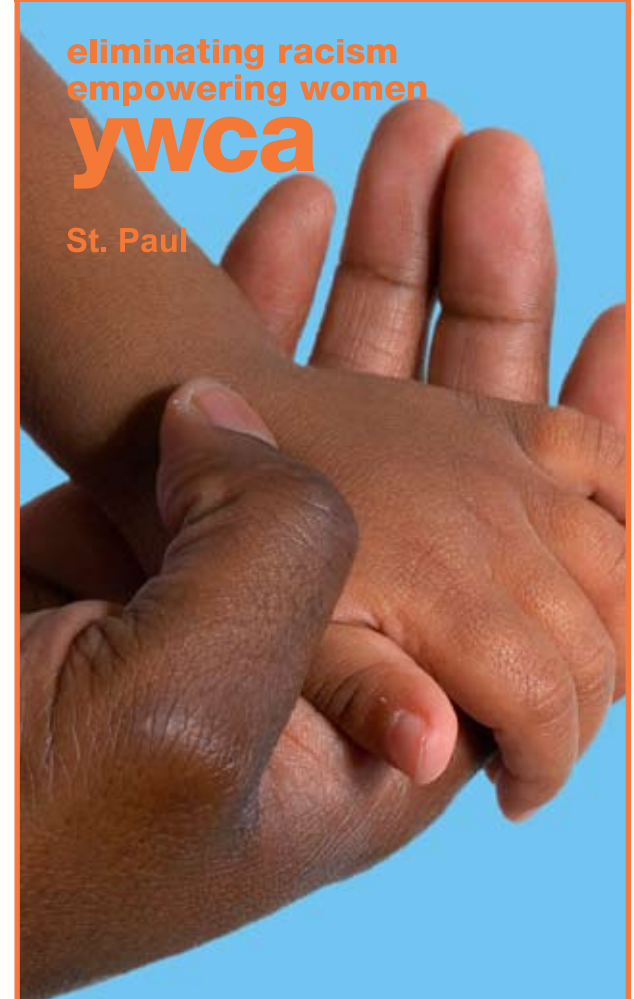

internship opportunities

Interns make great contributions to our programs. Most internships are available year-round. We're committed to making sure you have the best internship experience possible!

The YWCA St. Paul offers internships in:

Administration

Assist our Network Administrator as an IT intern, troubleshoot problems and offer desktop support.

Youth Development

A variety of internships are available working with youth in case management, program development, direct child care and tutoring.

Housing & Supportive Services

A variety of internships are available working directly with the women and/or families in our Transitional Housing or other Supportive Services programs.

Health & Wellness

Assist Health & Fitness Center members through instruction in the use of basic weight and cardio machines.

special event & project opportunities

Drives

Sponsor a drive for Youth Development or the Transitional Housing Program (THP). Select a drive that works for you: school supplies, household goods, school uniforms, toys, birthday bags, cell phones, neighbor to neighbor baskets, infant care supplies or healthy snacks.

Service Projects

Throw a party for kids, help with spring cleaning or paint programming space. There are a variety of ways your group can get involved.

Special Projects

If you are interested in helping out with a special event or short-term project as an individual or group, contact our HR Generalist.

Past special projects have included painting a child care center, assembling journals for youth programs, sponsoring a field trip or leading arts and crafts activities for children in our Transitional Housing Program.

ongoing volunteer opportunities

Housing & Supportive Services

Rock babies and play with toddlers while homeless moms attend class, assist with a special event, assemble welcome baskets, or lend your expertise as a life skills instructor or job coach.

Youth Development

Provide homework assistance, share a skill or hobby, assist with a special event, prepare teens for the ACT test or their first job interview. Group and individual opportunities are available after school and during release days.

Skills for Life & Work

Help students in grades K-3 to become better readers or assist students in grades K-8 to build basic skills in reading and math.

Administration

Help with the day-to-day tasks such as stuffing envelopes, filing and making copies.
