Youth Achievers Program (YAP): Equips at-risk youth ages 8-14 with the skills, attitudes and experiences they will need to succeed and grow. After school and summer programming focuses on life skills, academic enrichment and healthy minds/bodies.

Accepting referrals from area schools, TIP, Ramsey County Child Protection Services, law enforcement, social workers, probation officers and other community agencies, YAP reaches out to youth whose behavioral, emotional and/or educational issues typically preclude them from being successful in traditional after school and summer programs.

Transportation:

Parents are responsible for arranging transportation to and from the YWCA.
