## now accepting referrals

Youth Achievers Program (YAP): Equips at-risk youth ages 8-14 with the skills, attitudes and experiences they will need to succeed and grow. After school and summer programming focuses on life skills, academic enrichment and healthy minds/bodies.

Accepting referrals from area schools, TIP, Ramsey County Child Protection Services, law enforcement, social workers, probation officers and other community agencies, YAP reaches out to youth whose behavioral, emotional and/or educational issues typically preclude them from being successful in traditional after school and summer programs.

### **School Year Program Dates & Hours:**

September 8 – June 11, 2010

Monday – Friday

2:30 – 6:00 pm (a daily snack is provided)

**Transportation:** Parents are responsible for arranging transportation to and from the YWCA. Typically, transportation to the YWCA can be arranged through a child's school.

Limited transportation, within a specific zone may be available for families who do not have other means of transportation.

**Attendance & Participation:** To ensure a meaningful and successful experience, participants must commit to:

- Attend three or more days each week
- Arrive by 4:30 pm
- Depart no earlier than 5:45 pm

**Fee:** \$50 registration fee per family
